



Green Mountain Care: Answers Before Implementation

The Vermont Legislature has enacted and the Shumlin Administration is implementing Green Mountain Care, Vermont's experiment in single-payer government-monopoly health care, before knowing how much it will cost or how we will pay for it. Furthermore, the Legislature has outlawed the private insurance market for 100,000 Vermonters as of January 1, 2014. We, the undersigned, urge the Vermont Legislature to cease implementation of Green Mountain Care until the Governor Shumlin's three-way test is satisfied:

"We will only go ahead [with Green Mountain Care] if we're convinced together as a state, that the system is better than what we have, that it costs less, it's going to help create jobs, and we've got the cost containment system right.
